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GENERAL PRE-CONCERT INFORMATION

1.) SOUND RE-INFORCEMENT: In most cases, **4 His Love**, will use our own sound system and will need to set up 1½-2 hours before the start of service/concert. If we are joining you for a Sunday morning worship service, we will need to know if your sanctuary is used for Sunday School; we will time our arrival so we are finished with our setup and sound check prior to the class time if that is the case. Please have the building open and a representative available at the arranged time – someone who can let us know what furniture may or may not be moved, etc. We recognize that some auditoriums have specific sound challenges, and we will be happy to work with your sound people to make sure the audience gets the best possible sound. If you think there are sound issues we should be aware of, have one of your sound people contact us well before the event so we know what needs to be done before we arrive.

2.) CD/PRODUCT TABLE: Please provide one 6'-8' table in a high-traffic area (preferably the foyer or entry/exit hall) for product display. (We DO bring a table with us, in case you do not have one readily available. We promise: We will NOT "huckster" our merchandise, just tastefully let people know what is available.)

3.) MEALS: A light meal after the service would be appreciated. **4 His Love** prefers not to eat before ministering, unless the event includes a meal open to all who attend; in such a case, we enjoy eating with everyone else and including the fellowship as ministry time, whether before or after the service. Some churches hold a potluck or church dinner or provide some light refreshments as a way of making the experience more relaxed and hospitable for all attending. You should plan to do what is most suitable for your congregation and the specific event. Sandwiches, chips and water are more than adequate from our perspective. Please let us know what those plans are well in advance so we can plan our meals for the rest day appropriately.

4.) LODGING: In some cases – especially when the group is on a longer tour – lodging assistance will be appreciated for either the night before or the night of the event. If your event is one of these, the need will be made known to you before you commit to the event. Our only request is that separate beds be provided for each of us. Two rooms with two beds each are preferred.
